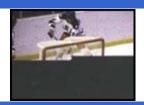
Progressive Scanning

Progressive Scanning: The frame/picture is made up of one field—consisting of 525 lines (480 viewable) or 765 lines (720 viewable)



All horizontal lines are scanned in succession in a single pass



This presents an entire picture in 1/60th of a second (twice as fast as interlaced)

Progressive scan reduces artifacts such as aliasing and increases brightness.
