<u>Comments concerning the data that may raise a reasonable doubt with regards to driving abilities</u>

The data/information which may give rise to a reasonable doubt with regards to driving abilities can relate to a variety of elements (diagnosis, medication, observations, screening tests, neuropsychological tests, ...) depending, amongst other factors, on the professional in question as each professional has specific professional activities delineated by the Code des Professions du Québec. As such, in order to minimize the risk of a disciplinary action from the Professional order, the reasonable doubt must be in relation to one's professional field of practice, for example, for an occupational therapist, it must pertain to the user's functional abilities.
