TEACHER'S PORTFOLIO

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What is a portfolio?

- A portfolio is a compilation of teachers past and on-going accomplishment.
- It contains all the evidences that support the claims of the teacher in the appraisal system.
- It contains the teachers' thoughts, insights, feelings about teaching-learning among others that relate to their everyday life in the school setting.

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What is a Portfolio?

- Your guide in the preparation of a Teacher's Portfolio is your copy of the Performance Rating (PAST). The First and Second Semester PAST can be placed in your portfolio.
- Remember that your performance rating depends on your accomplishment for every semester.

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What is the purpose of a Teacher's Portfolio?

- To showcase results of assessment of strengths and weaknesses, plans for professional development, and improvement of learning outcomes.
- It should contain corresponding accomplishments as evidences of teaching performance.

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 The Cover – it contains the title of your portfolio. The title should tells something about yourself. It can be your characteristic or attitude.

The introduction contains the data about the title you've chosen. Tell why you chose the title.

Self Introduction

Tell important information about yourself:

Personal Data / Educational Background/ Teaching Experience / Achievements/ Copy of your Performance Rating

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What are the content of a Portfolio?

- All About Your Class
 - 1. Class Officers pupils and parents
 - 2. Class Reading Profile
 - 3. Class Nutritional Status
 - Class Profile age/ sex profile/ class enrolment
 - 5. Remedial Instruction Program with the list of slow learners

- All About Your Class
 - 6. Classroom Program
 - 7. Class Standing (for Honor Pupils/ Pupils' Ranking)
 - 8. Best Pupils in Class (Quarterly)

You can think of other data. Just be creative.

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What are the content of a Portfolio?

- The Teacher's Performance Rating is divided into three (3):
 - I. Instructional Competence
 - A. Lesson Planning and Delivery/ Assessment / Management of Time and Learning Environment
 - B. Learner's Achievement
 - C. School Home and Community Involvement

- What are the content of a Portfolio?
- The Instructional Competence contains the following:
 - Observation Notes
 - On-the-Spot Test Result
 - Self-Made Test Paper with Table of Specification
 - Instructional Materials made (pictures) plus a short description.
 - Quarterly Test Result with analysis

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What are the content of a Portfolio?

- List of your Homeroom PTA Officers
- Minutes of your Classroom Meeting with pictorials
- Project implemented by your Homeroom PTA Officers
- Home visit conducted certificate of appearance
- List of School Activities attended with date and venue of the activity.
